The South Suffolk Show, Sunday 14th May 2023

Now in its 134th year, The South Suffolk Show is a celebration of country life and regarded by many as one of the leading one-day agricultural shows in the eastern region.

The 'South Suffolk' takes place at Ampton racecourse, near Ingham, Suffolk. This site not only has excellent road links to the towns of Newmarket, Sudbury, Thetford and Bury St Edmunds, but also provides the show with a picturesque countryside setting.

Traditionally we have enjoyed crowds in the region of 10 - 15,000, flocking to see the ring attractions and 100 plus tradestands catering for the country lifestyle.

The main ring attraction to entertain the crowds this year will be the amazing **Bolddog FMX** motorcycle display team, performing astonishing death-defying freestyle stunts as seen in the semi-finals of series 8 of 'Britain's Got Talent', - and who Simon Cowell called "one of the most incredible things we've ever had on this show".

In addition the show traditionally has a high number of entries in its various horse and pony classes, and our cattle, sheep and pig classes are also extremely well supported. Over the years the show has produced a number of National Champions.

Throughout the showground we strive to entertain all members of the family with attractions including traditional fairground rides, the New Zealand style 'Sheep Road Show', a vintage farm machinery display, a wood carving display and auction, a farriery competition, gun dog displays, terrier racing and the Ferretworld Roadshow, not to mention the Art and Craft Marquee packed with unique creations, the Food Hall full of tempting treats, and new for this year; Eat Street complete with cookery demonstrations and a great selection of speciality artisan food vendors.

This year will be our tenth year on the extended 95 acre showground, allowing us to have more car parking areas, as well as a dedicated horse area, with improved ground conditions, which have been much appreciated by our visitors and exhibitors in recent years.

Gates open at 8:30am, and trade stands pack up at 5pm. Tickets on the gate this year will cost £15.00 per adult, £7 for children aged up to 16 and £10 for concessions, with children under 5 going free. Alternatively a family ticket for 2 adults and up to 3 children will be available for purchase at £35.
