The South Suffolk Show, Sunday 12th May 2024

Now in its 135th year, The South Suffolk Show is a celebration of country life and regarded by many as one of the leading one-day agricultural shows in the eastern region.

The 'South Suffolk' takes place at Ampton racecourse, near Ingham, Suffolk. This site not only has excellent road links to the towns of Newmarket, Sudbury, Thetford and Bury St Edmunds, but also provides the show with a picturesque countryside setting.

Traditionally we have enjoyed crowds in the region of 10 - 15,000, flocking to see the ring attractions and 100 plus tradestands catering for the country lifestyle.

Ring attractions to entertain the crowds this year will include the HOH Equine team who will be performing in the Grand Ring with their highly skilled team of performance horses and riders, demonstrating poise and precision with an inspiring display of classical dressage, liberty, stunt and trick riding. Whilst the Shetland Pony Grand National will provide a gutsy spectacle of speed.

In addition the show traditionally has a high number of entries in its various horse and pony classes, and our cattle, sheep and pig classes are also extremely well supported. Over the years the show has produced a number of National Champions.

Throughout the showground we strive to entertain all members of the family with attractions including traditional fairground rides, the New Zealand style 'Sheep Road Show', a vintage farm machinery display, a farriery competition, gun dog displays, terrier racing and the Ferretworld Roadshow, not to mention the Art and Craft Marquee packed with unique creations, the Food Hall full of tempting treats, and Eat Street complete with cookery demonstrations and a great selection of speciality artisan food vendors.

This year will be our eleventh year on the extended 95acre showground, allowing us to have more car parking areas, as well as a dedicated horse area, with improved ground conditions, which have been much appreciated by our visitors and exhibitors in recent years.

Gates open at 8:30am, and trade stands pack up at 5pm. Tickets on the gate this year will cost £18.00 per adult, £10 for children aged up to 16 and £12 for concessions, with children under 5 going free. Alternatively, a family ticket for 2 adults and up to 3 children will be available for purchase at £40. And 'early bird' discounted ticket offers are available from a selection of local retails and online at www.southsuffolkshow.co.uk until 7pm on Sunday 5th May.
