Rules and Conditions of Entry

i) Entries will be accepted on a first come basis, however due to space limitations on the showground the number of exhibits is limited to a maximum of 50, and the Association reserves the right to refuse entry to any Exhibitor at its discretion without giving reason.

Vehicle pass(es), entrance tickets and exhibit numbers will be sent by post, prior to the Show.

Additional tickets may be sent at the discretion of the show if more than 6 exhibits have been entered, please ensure that you have enough tickets. *Additional tickets may be purchased from the Secretary at reduced rates if requested prior to 10th April 2026.*

Every person entering the showground must have a valid entrance ticket or pay the full price of admission at the gate (£20). This regulation will be strictly enforced. The show will not take responsibility for any tickets, which may have been mislaid or forgotten. No refunds will be considered unless application is made in writing to the Secretary. An Exit pass system will be in force.

iii) Vehicle Movements:

Vehicles carrying issued passes will only be admitted to the Showground up to **8.30 a.m.** All transport vehicles not forming part of the display must, for the reasons of safety, be removed to the allocated parking areas by **8.30 a.m.** **No vehicles will be allowed on to the showground after 8.30 a.m. Breakdown:** No Vehicles will be allowed access onto the showground before **5.00 pm.** It will be at the Show Directors discretion to vary this time if prevailing circumstances and / or conditions warrant it.

Vehicles taking part in ring displays will be supervised whilst travelling between parking/display area and ring. Vehicles must be unloaded in the designated parking area and not in the display area.

iv) The Organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone should take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the Show Committee and all the Officials and Stewards at all times.

v) Trading of any form, without the express permission of the organisers is forbidden and may result in expulsion from the showground.

vi) The Association reserves the sole right of decision to postpone, cancel, abandon or curtail the show. Where such decisions arise, from directive, happenings or circumstances outside the control of the Association, it shall not create liability to claim for loss or damage. The refund of fees will be at the discretion of the Association.

vii) **Disclaimer of Liability:**

In this clause, the term Exhibitor shall include persons taking part in any competition or display arranged by the Show Committee, and the owner of any animal, plant, machinery or other thing involved in any such competition or display or otherwise exhibited on the Showground.

Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Committee, its servants or agents, the Committee will not be responsible for death, injury, disease, damage or loss caused to any exhibitor or to his servant or agent or to any animal, article, plant, machinery or thing of whatever nature brought on to Showground by the said exhibitor from whatever cause death, injury, disease, damage or loss arises.

Save as aforesaid the exhibitor shall indemnify the Committee against all claims, damages, and expenses whatsoever in any way arising out of the presence of the exhibitor, his servant, agents, exhibits, vehicles or equipment on the Showground and shall assume full responsibility therefore. **Exhibitors must have insurance against any third party claims.** Acceptance of the foregoing provision shall be a condition of entry.

Limited camping facilities are available by prior arrangement only.
